New Members – Club Rules

- 1. NEW MEMBERS ARE NOT ALLOWED TO PURCHASE ALCOHOL. New members can only buy alcohol after full approval.
- 2. Ranges and Pond are for the use of Active or Life members ONLY. New members' children (under age 15) are allowed to use these facilities while under the member's supervision.
- 3. Shooting Range hours start at 10:00 AM and end at dusk, unless noted for an event.
- 4. Archery Range- Targets are for use of target or field tips **ONLY**. There is a Broad-head target at the 20 yard range which is clearly marked. This is the only place to use Broad-heads.
- 5. Shotgun Patterning Range is for shotshells **ONLY**. Pistols and rifles are **NOT** to be used on this range.
- 6. The Pistol Range is for **ONLY** for the use of handguns.
- 7. Rapid fire is not allowed at any time. There must be at least 3 seconds between shots.
- 8. Only paper or clay targets are allowed. Targets must be properly placed on the rubber target holder.
- 9. All members must sign in at the ranges.
- 10. Ranges are for the use of **MEMBERS ONLY**. No guests are permitted to be at the ranges. Must be Junior Active, Active or Life members to be allowed on the ranges.
- 11. Alcohol cannot be removed from the bar area, unless taken out the side door for consumption in the pavilion. All alcohol intended for consumption in the pavilion may **NOT** be removed from the pavilion area: i.e. taken into the parking lot, to the pond or the ranges is not permitted.

- 12. No outside alcohol may be brought into the Clubhouse for consumption. All alcohol must be purchased at the bar.
- 13. Meetings: General Membership Meeting is held on the second Tuesday of every month at 8:00 PM. Fish and Game Meeting is held on the third Tuesday of every month at 7:30 PM.
- 14. Trap Shooting is on Wednesday evenings in the Spring, Summer and Fall starting at 5:30 PM and also every Saturday year-round starting at 10:00 AM. Non-Members are allowed to shoot trap during these times.
- 15. <u>Club By-Laws, Clubhouse Rules and Range Rules are kept</u> behind the bar and on the bulletin board in the clubhouse and every member should read them and follow all club rules.
- 16. Enjoy the Club! *Help keep it clean* and see a board member for additional information. *Get involved*, help out when you can.
- 17. Tree Stands on Club Property: A safety harness MUST be worn at ALL TIMES when using a tree stand on club property.
 NO EXCEPTIONS. All tree stands MUST have a metal tag with your name and address affixed. Tree stands MUST be removed within 2 weeks after state deer season ends.
